- One (1) site per Member number.
- Please use the site area (7.5m x 6m) that has been allocated to you.
- One (1) car per site. Additional cars are to be parked in the allocated parking areas on the Complex.
- All caravans and mobile units are required to have a fire extinguisher and fire blanket.
- During your stay at the Canine Complex ALL campers are instructed to use the onsite Amenities.
- In wet weather please ensure that if you use electrical extension leads that you have them adequately covered by wet weather housing
- Please keep your site clean and use waste bins provided.
- Consider others and ensure noise levels are kept to a minimum.
- No Generators after 10pm and before 7am.
- Keep all your valuable safe as they are your responsibility.
- Leave the amenities block i.e. shower, toilets and hand basins clean and tidy.
- Leave the camp site in the original condition that you found it. If your site is left dirty, you will be recharged \$300 cleaning fee.
- Ensure that you familiarise yourself with the Evacuation Plan.
- Strictly no fires allowed of any description.
- Sites cannot be resold to another camper once purchased by you.
- If you wish to stay later than 10:00AM on any day, then you must book and pay for an extra daily site fee.

CAMPING CANCELLATION POLICY

Due to limited availability of camping sites, we request that you cancel at least seven (7) days before your original booking. This gives us the opportunity to make this available to another Hirer. You may cancel by phone, email or online. If you must cancel or change your booking, we will offer you a refund less a \$10.00 administration fee, if you cancel before the seven (7) day period prior to your booking. However, if you do not cancel seven (7) days prior, you will lose the payment for the booking. DOGS NSW reserves the right to vary their decision at any time.
