

DOGS NSW - REPRESENTATIVE REPORT FOR AN AGILITY TRIAL

- 1. The DOGS NSW Representative is appointed by authority of Regulations Part II Show 2.8.
- 2. The Representative's sole duty is to observe and make an unbiased report to The Secretary of DOGS NSW on matters affecting the general conduct of the Trial and in particular any matters of controversy, which arose, and on all breaches of the Regulations, which occurred thereat.
- 3. The Representative shall not participate in any decision-making processes pertaining to or affecting the conduct of the Trial. In particular the Representative should not interpret Regulations or express an opinion in relation to any procedure, irregularity, protest or complaint.
- 4. The Representative should refer any inquiry in relation to the show directly to the Affiliate or Committee conducting the Trial.

5. The Representative should attend and observe any inquiry held at the Trial in relation to an Aggressive Dog Incident for the purposes of reporting only. Any party to the inquiry should not ask the Representative for advice.									
6. The Representative's Report must be lodged to the Secretary DOGS NSW no later than seven (7) days after the close of the show.
