- d. Be approved by DOGS NSW

To be eligible to judge Herding Test classes the applicant must have:

- Trained and trialled a dog to a Pre-Trial Test title
- b. Acted as a Scribe and Stock Handler a minimum of three times.

To be eligible to judge Herding Trial classes the applicant must have:

- a. Met the eligibility criteria to Judge Herding Test level
- b. Acted as Stock Handler for a minimum of three Herding Trials
- Acted as Scribe at least once for Started, Intermediate and Advanced class levels of the course(s) applied for (i.e A and /or B and /or C)
- Trained and trialled a dog to a Started title or above (preferably in the course(s) applied for).

Applicants who do not yet meet all the stock handling and scribing criteria may be considered if they commit to and meet the relevant criteria by the 30th September 2019.
