



DOGS NSW - APPLICATION FOR MEMBERSHIP

IMPORTANT NOTES:

1. NSW residents must be a member of DOGS NSW to be eligible to enter, exhibit or handle a dog in all Shows or Trials conducted within Australia.
2. Interstate residents are required to hold a current membership with the Member Body in the State that they reside to be eligible to enter, exhibit or handle at any Shows or Trials conducted outside their State of residence.
3. Renewal of membership will be due 1 July each year. A renewal notice and reminder notice will be sent via email.
4. Membership cards are issued digitally and can be accessed via the DOGS NSW mobile app.

Only one (1) Nominee is permitted on this membership. This applies to all memberships which are to be in the name of the members' prefix or kennels. A Junior member: (iv) shall not be eligible to hold any office under the Articles or to submit his name as a candidate for appointment as a judge; (ii) shall not be entitled to vote at any meeting; (iii) shall not be entitled to hold a prefix
<input type="checkbox"/>	ASSOCIATE MEMBERSHIP; (Single membership only)	An Associate Member: (iv) shall not be eligible to hold any office under the Articles or to submit his name as a candidate for appointment as a judge; (ii) shall not be entitled to vote at any meeting; (iii) shall not be entitled to hold a prefix; (iv) shall not be eligible for nomination to, or election as a member of the Board of Directors and may not vote in any ballot in any such election.
