



Road closures and night work on Luddenham Road from Monday 17 February 2025

Mamre Road upgrade

Transport for NSW acknowledges the Dharug people of the Tharawal Nation as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pays respect to Elders past and present.

Transport for NSW is upgrading Mamre Road between the M4 Motorway, St Clair and Erskine Park Road, Erskine Park to reduce congestion and improve safety and travel times.

What work are we doing?

A section of Luddenham Road between Mamre Road and Elizabeth Drive will be temporarily closed for **three night shifts** between **8pm** and **5am** on **Wednesday 19, Thursday 20 and Friday 21 February**, weather permitting.

The temporary road closure is part of our night work on Luddenham Road to install drainage. This work will occur between **Monday 17 and Friday 28 February**.

Our work activities will include:

- installing temporary traffic control, signage and safety barriers
- saw cutting road surfaces
- digging a 4-metre deep trench across Luddenham Road
- installing new water drainage pipes
- reinstating the road surface.

For the safety of our workers and road users, and to minimise traffic disruption, it is necessary to completely close Luddenham Road when we dig the trench during our **three night temporary closures** noted above.

We will reopen Luddenham Road to the public after every night shift.

Our work schedule

Our hours of work are between **6pm** and **6am**, **Monday to Saturday**, to allow for setting up and packing up after each shift.

If our work is impacted by weather, we will close Luddenham Road on the following week between **8pm** and **5am** on **Monday 24, Tuesday 25 and Wednesday 26 February**.

We will notify you in advance if this takes place.

Detours and traffic changes

Detours will be in place during the temporary closure of Luddenham Road via The Northern Road, M4 Motorway, Elizabeth Drive and Mamre Road. See detour map on the next page.

Please keep to speed limits and follow the direction of traffic controllers and signs.

Resident access

Traffic control will be in place to maintain resident and emergency service access. **No other vehicles will be permitted to enter during this closure.**

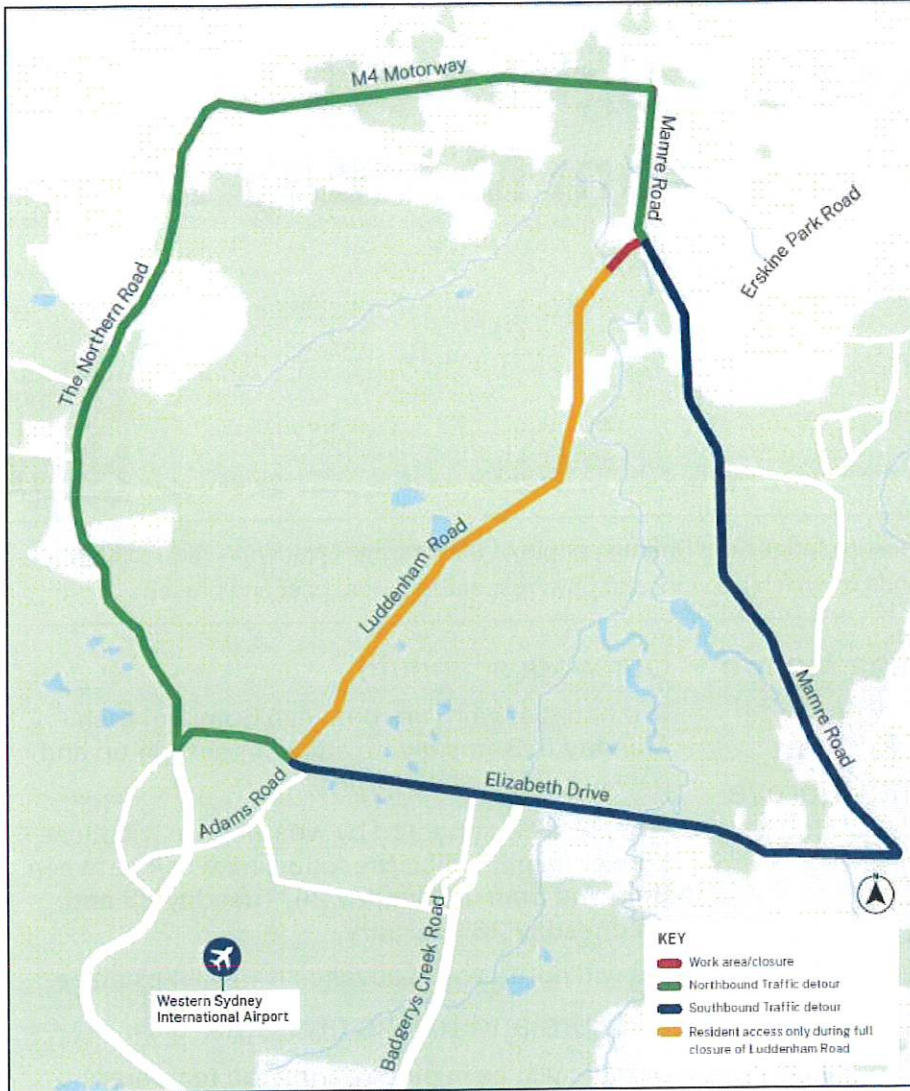
What will this mean for you?

During night work, you may see increased activities in the area. We may use excavators, vacuum truck, rollers, bobcats, mobile cranes, light and heavy vehicles, hand power tools, road saws and lighting towers.

Our work will be noisy at times. We will do everything we can to minimise its impact, including completing noisier activities by midnight, minimising light spill and turning off equipment and machinery when not in use.
